By submitting this entry form the competitor, who must be a current member of QYUTA, acknowledges that they will not hold QYUTA nor the host event; The Goondiwindi P&A Society, their management committee's, members nor the Trial Organising Committee responsible for any illness or injury that may occur as a direct or indirect result of attending this trial.

The competitor accepts acknowledge that working with livestock may put me at risk of illness or injury and that in attending this trial, I accept that I may be injured from both foreseen and unforeseen events associated with working livestock and dogs.

The handler/owner of the dog certifies that the entered dog/s is/are not a hazard to any persons, livestock or property.

Battle of the Sexes - SPECIAL RULES APPLY.

- 1. Handlers are limited to 4 entries and can enter dogs of both sexes.
- 2. If entries allow, there will be a second round on Saturday night.
- 3. 4 Teams of 5 dogs will be drawn from 2 hats. As a competitor you may be in multiple teams. As your dog's name is drawn from the hat, that will be the order you will run in your assigned team.
- 4. The order of the draw will be the first handler of Team 1 Bitches then Team 2 Dogs and so forth until all teams have had a run. Handlers can assign a name to their Team.
- 5. There will be no final, The Team with the most points wins the prize pool of \$250 and each dog's handler will receive \$50.
- 6. In the event of a tie between the top points scoring Dogs and Bitches teams, there will be a runoff (if time permits) between the top dog and top bitch from the tied teams.
- 7. In the event of a tie for the position of Top Dog or Top Bitch Team, then the highest and lowest score within that team will be combined to determine the Top Team.
