Working dogs are an essential tool for a stockman. One dog can do the work of six to eight men and the dog never calls in sick on a Monday morning. Working dogs are also weatherproof and are happy to work for pats and kibble.

The Farm Dog Survey by Sydney University found that a working dog costs a Stockman around \$8,000 in its lifetime but does about \$40,000 worth of work in its lifetime.
